Ants and Butterflies will be spending the day at the forest in Haslingfield on Wednesday, some of our Year 3/4 girls will take part in a football festival on Thursday and Reception – Year 5 will be enjoying Archaeology Day




Safeguarding at Thriplow



School painting - summer help needed!


